

Pool Rules

DO NOT drink alcohol or use narcotics and swim. Persons who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or narcotics will not be allowed into pool area.

Flotation devices other than US Coast Guard Type I-III level are not permitted in pool. (This includes noodles, floats, swimmies and learning pads)

All persons entering must present their pass to the attendant. No one will be allowed entrance without a pass.

No Running, jumping, wrestling or rough play in or out of water

NO DIVING

No somersaults or cannonballs from side of pool or any other unsafe activities

Do not climb on the back of other swimmers.

Children who are not toilet-trained and less than four years old must wear a swim diaper or plastic pants and swimsuit. Cloth or disposable diapers are not permitted.

NO SMOKING Inside pool area or within 50 ft. of pool fence.

No pets inside pool or picnic area

Pool Rules (Continued)

No pool parties.

No loud, raucous behavior.

NO GLASS containers or bottles allowed in pool area.

All patrons must shower with soap before entering pool.

Persons with cuts, sores, bandages, colds, coughs or infected eyes are not permitted in pool.

Proper swim attire must be worn while swimming in pool. Street clothing, shoes, thong bathing suits are not allowed to be worn in pool.

Spitting, spouting, nose-blowing or any foul gestures are not permitted.

No foul or abusive language.

All trash must be disposed of in trash bins.

The SCD rules and requests made by marina personnel must always be followed. Persons failing to follow rules will be asked to leave and are subject to revocation of pool membership and passes.

NEVER SWIM ALONE. A minimum of 2 adults, 18 years of age or older, must be present whenever this swimming facility is in use.

THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied to the bathing facility by a parent or guardian (an adult who is responsible for the children and their behavior)

IN AN EMERGENCY, NOTIFY FACILITY OPERATOR AND CONTACT HELP AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. A free telephone is provided outside the pump house entrance. **Dial 911.**

Telephone numbers for the nearest emergency medical service are posted. **ONLY USE THIS FACILITY DURING POSTED HOURS OF OPERATION**

The pool membership is for West Shore Marina customers only. Suffolk County, the Town of Huntington, and our insurance company have permitted this pool as a non-public, members-only pool. Marina members are boat owners who signed a contract. ~~Any guests must be registered in person by boat owner in marina office and must be accompanied in the pool area by boat owner at all times. Boat owners may not send guests to pool unaccompanied. Guests are defined as anyone other than boat owner.~~

NO GUESTS DURING COVID-19. These applications will be strictly enforced. Any person protesting to these rules may opt to cancel pool membership with full refund.



The swimming facility at West Shore Marina is not supervised by a lifeguard or other responsible person. In place of on-site supervision, this facility has established a series of safeguards to be followed by all guests.

We are required to notify you of these rules, to ensure that water rescue equipment is at the pool and that the swimming area is maintained in accordance with the New York State Department of Health guidelines and requirements. In the interest of your safety, we require you to follow these rules.

Please read the safety rules located at the entrance and outlined in this brochure.

After you have read this brochure, please sign the tear-off section provided and return it to us to collect your pool pass. Only marina members who have received and read this brochure will receive pool passes and may use the bathing area.
